
Arrange a Refreshingly Natural, Emotionally Gratifying Encounter with Hakka Culture

REVISITING HAKKA HERITAGE

Explore Trails that Once Linked Taiwan to the World



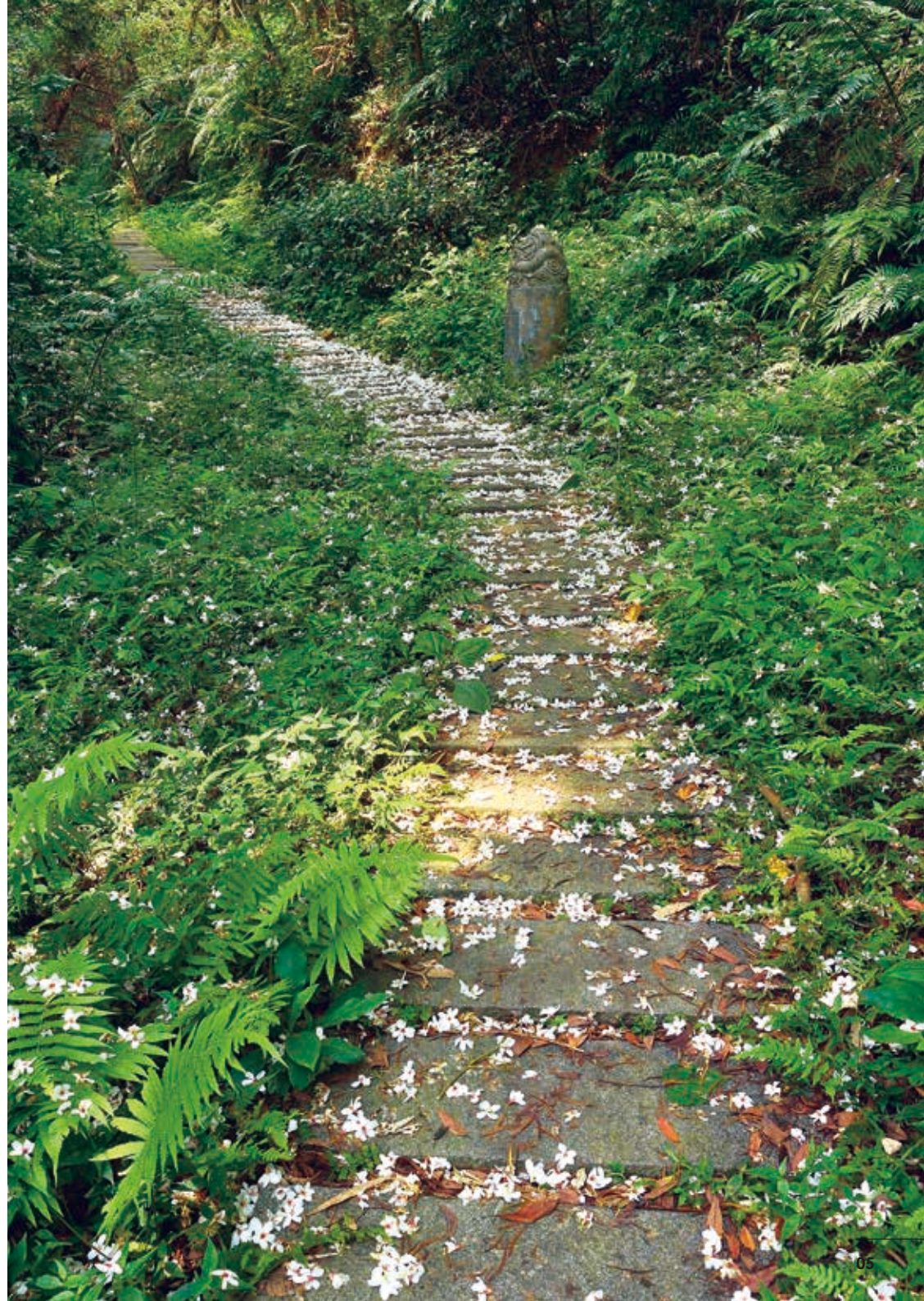
Connecting the upland districts of Taoyuan, Hsinchu, Miaoli, and Taichung counties, Taiwan Romantic Route 3 is widely known as 'Hakka Cultural Boulevard'. The network of century-old trails and byways that intersects Route 3 and traverses the area's mountain forests, valleys, and scattered villages is an enticing portal into Hakka history. These footpaths, once a conduit for Taiwanese camphor and tea bound for international markets, have been restored as nature trails that are now known collectively as 'Raknus Selu'.

Centuries-old earth god temples, rice-mortared bridges, and other important historical and cultural sites still dot these old Hakka trails and byways, while Hakka elders safeguard and share the stories that give meaning to where we are today. All are part and parcel of our shared tangible and intangible Hakka heritage.

Of the dozens of 'tung blossom trails', Taoyuan County's Xiaocukeng Historic Trail; Hsinchu County's Shiherliao Trail and Dashanbei Tung Blossom Trails; and Miaoli County's Shenzhao Mountain Tung Flower

Snow Path and Mingfeng Historic Trail are officially part of the Raknus Selu trail network under the Taiwan Romantic Route 3 National Nature Trail Network and Development Plan. In the future, experts and volunteers will restore each trail in the network using sustainable eco-engineering methods and original, natural materials and will install a comprehensive outlay of clear signage and direction information in order to create exceptional scenic attractions that have something to offer to visitors of every age and interest.

This year, we will proudly add another five tung blossom trails to the Raknus Selu network. These include Hsinchu County's recently restored Dunan Ancient Trail and Taoyuan County's Da Niou Qi Historic Trail, Hsinchu County's Shiguang Old Trail, and Miaoli County's Laochonggui Trail and Shuizhaixia Historic Trail. We hope that this brochure will be a valuable guide to northwestern Taiwan 'Hakka country', helping you explore our mountain forests, experience Hakka heritage, and behold the beauty of tung blossom season.

Zhaiming Temple Historic Trail

Weaving together beautiful scenery and religious contemplation, this trail was built in the early 1920s by craftsmen hired by a 4th-generation grandchild of Li An-jia, the founder of Zhaiming Temple. Enjoy your stroll down this century-old, stone-slab trail and its seasonal tung blossom 'snowfalls'. Exit the trail at Daxi Old Street to enjoy the traditional sights, sounds, and flavors of this unique corner of Taiwan.

Shi Yi Zhi Ancient Trail

This trail, said to have been laid by an 11-fingered craftsman, is known as 'Shi Yi Zhi' (11 Fingers) in his honor. This dirt trail has easy-to-walk stairways fashioned from custom-cut railway sleepers. The delightfully burbling stream to the right of the pathway is peppered in springtime with snowy white tung blossoms.

Xiaocukeng Historic Trail



This quiet path connecting Cukeng and Shimen along Xiaocukeng Stream is an old oxcart path dating at least from the early 20th century. The area's vibrant ecology gives hikers close-up views of swallowtail butterflies and frogs. Running for 1.3 km in total length, this trail is most stunning in April and May when its wide and level surface is carpeted in snowy white tung blossoms.

Da Niou Qi Historic Trail



Qi means 'slope' in the Hakka dialect. In centuries past, this 240m-long cobblestone path connected Qingshuikeng farmers to their fields in the Sanlin area. Today, the trail is a splendid venue for enjoying annual tung blossom 'snows'.

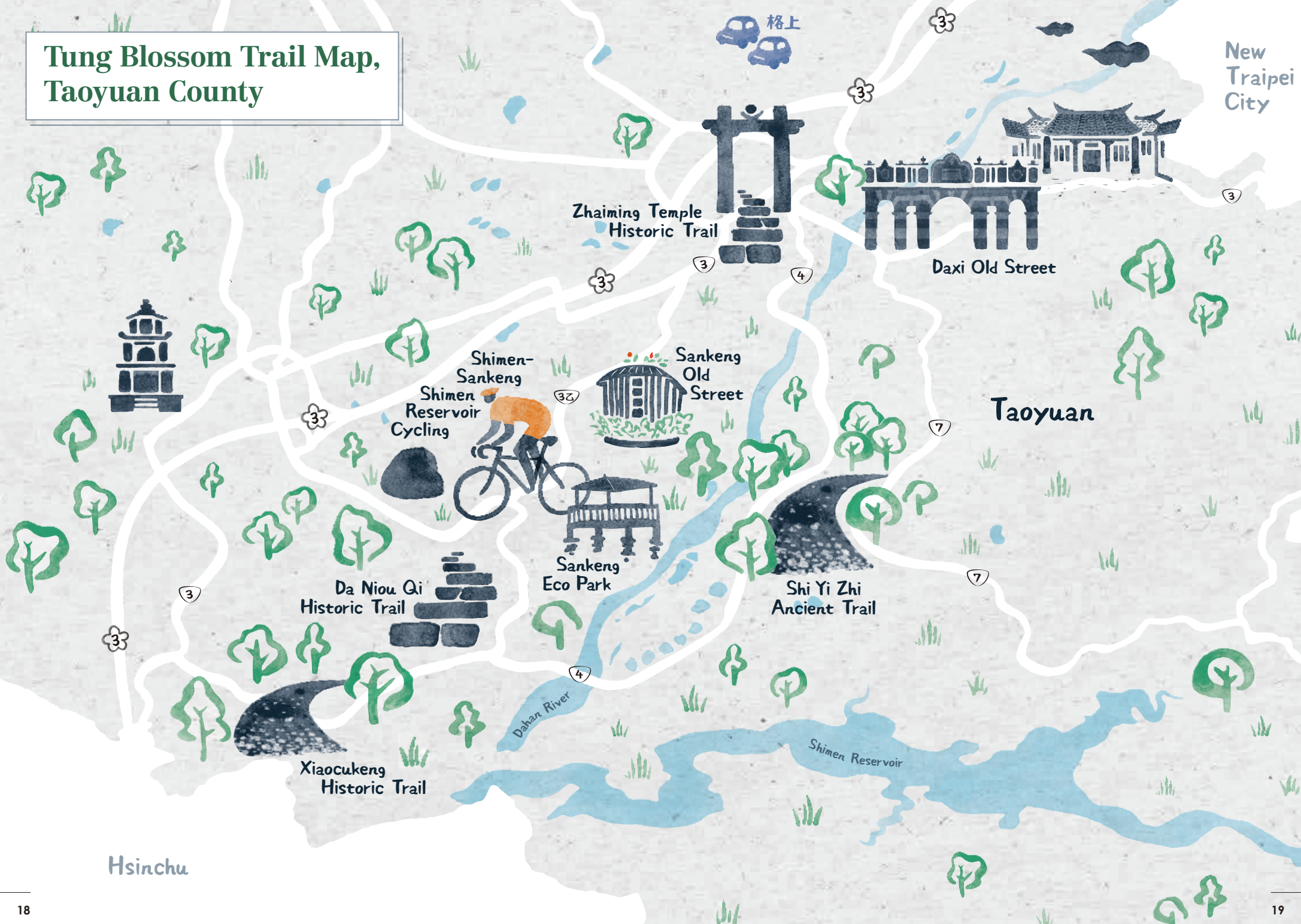
Shimen – Sankeng/Shimen Reservoir Cycling Track/ Shimen – Sankeng Biking Trail (Tung Blossom Trail)

The 7km-long Sankeng Biking Trail, one of northwest Taiwan's most popular cycling trails, connects cyclists and day walkers to popular destinations including Sankeng, Daping Red Bridge, Shimen Canal, the Sankeng-Daxi section of the Shimen Canal Bicycle Path, Kanjin Bridge, Sankeng Old Street, and Sankeng Eco Park. Come in April and May to revel in the springtime greenery interspersed with tung blossom trees in full, majestic bloom.

Sankeng Old Street

Sankeng (Three Gullies) is said to have been named for the three waterways that pass through the area. Sankeng Old Street, which runs along Dahan River, was an important stop for river trade and commerce and was once Longtan's busiest and most prosperous thoroughfare back in the day. Heibaishi (black and white) Gully was where local Hakka women once gathered to do their laundry. The two-century-old Yongfu Temple sits regally at the end of Sankeng Street. Sankeng Old Street is an exceptional destination to experience Hakka culture and see iconic temples and countryside scenery.

Sankeng Eco Park

Set along the bank of the Shimen Reservoir's Dahan River, Sankeng Eco Park is an expansive, ecofriendly green space that embraces a large eco-lake and spacious recreational grounds framed by lush, untamed mountains. Renhe Trail

Renhe Trail, a popular spot for Tung blossom viewing, may be accessed from either Jinshi Temple or Hukou Old Street (behind Sanyuan Temple). This 960m path traverses Tung Blossom Park's tung-tree forest (next to Guniang Temple) and, when in full bloom, their flowers' light, floral perfume permeates the air. Renhe Trail is an ideal destination for families to enjoy spectacular views of tung trees in full bloom.

Dunan Ancient Trail

Take this trail to traverse emerald green mountains and forests peppered with tung trees, with the rice fields astride the Fengshan River unfolding in the valley before your eyes.

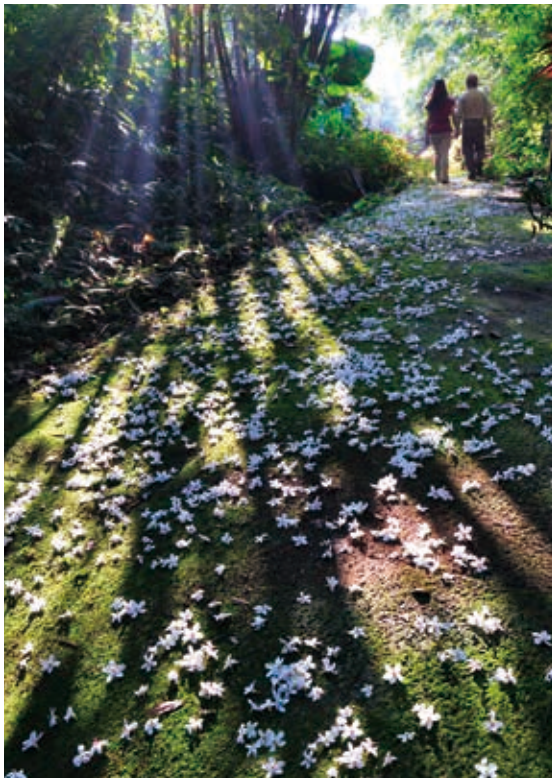

Luchukeng Tung Blossom Trail

This trail network, connecting Jianshan's Mifen Street and the Yongheshan Reservoir, has inner and outer ring routes. The inner ring is best for tung blossom viewing. This trail is shaded by dense forest along the ridgeline. Continue upward to the highest point to look out over the Taiwan Strait and the Zhunan area. During tung blossom season, the white tung blooms and green acacia trees here attract many tourists.

Today, renovated using eco-friendly methods, this trail integrates various mountain trails surround Taiwan Romantic Route 3. Wild nature and cultural sites make this historic trail highly worth exploring.

Skyline Bike Trail

Skyline Bike Trail is near Jiuhu Village in Tongluo, between Hutoukan Historic Trail and Tiaoyen Historic Trail. This bike trail passes by neatly planted rows of tea bushes and an old trail that was once used to transport salt and follows a mountainous route that takes hikers and cyclists into a visual, up-close smorgasbord of tung trees and snowy-white tung blossoms. 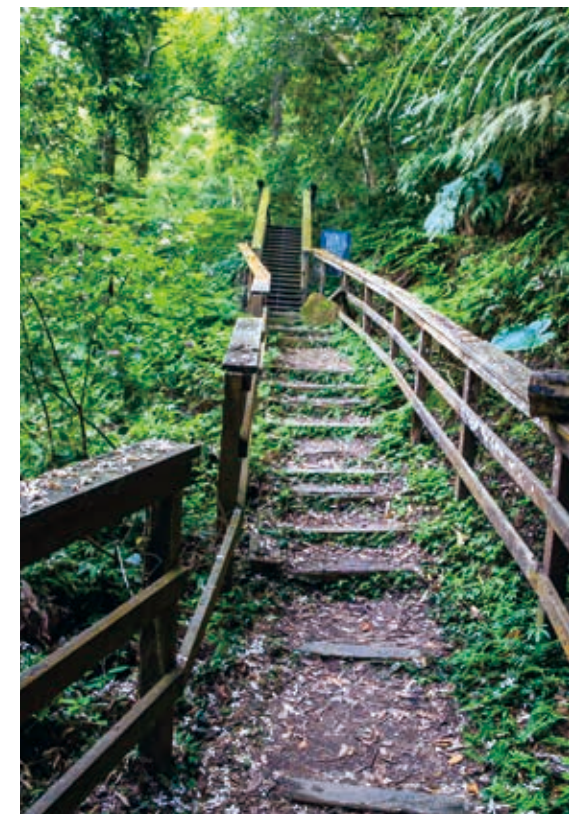
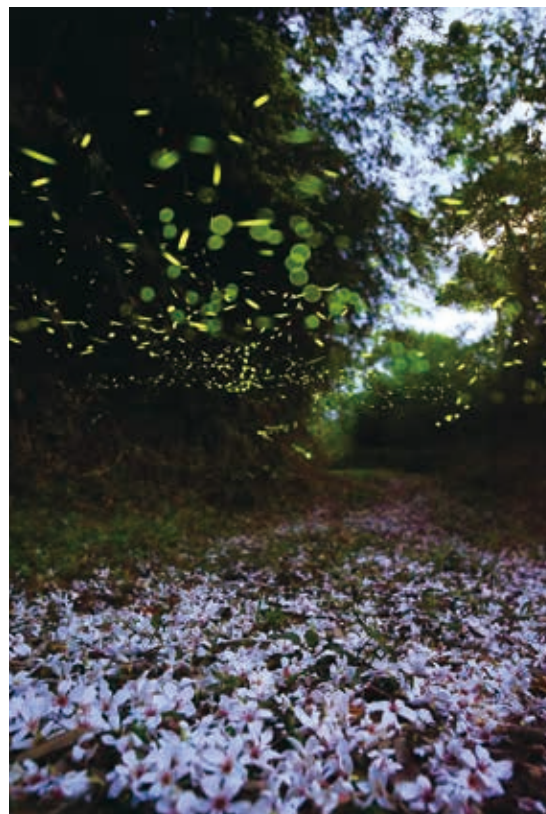

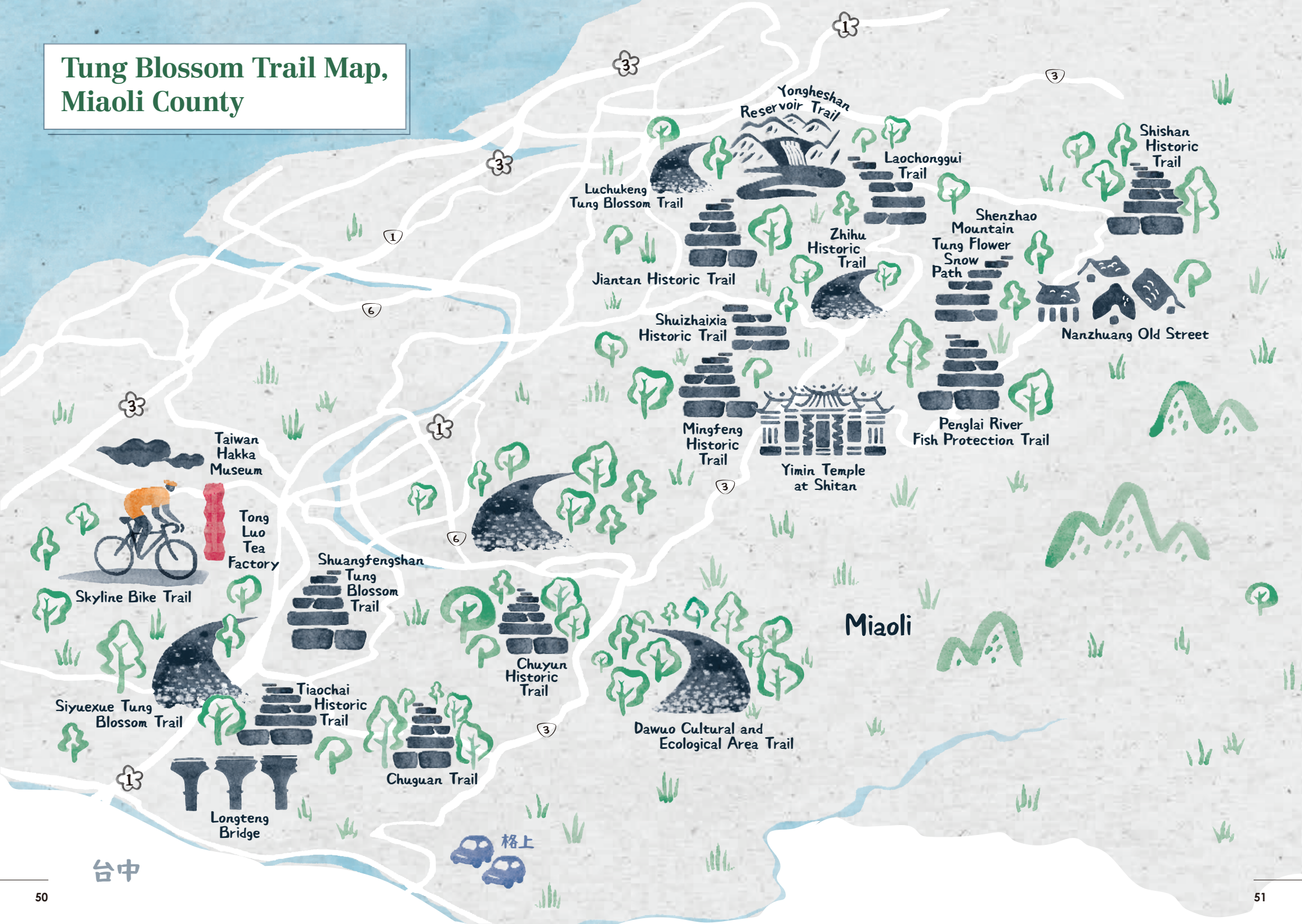
Dawuo Cultural and Ecological Area Trail

Longteng Bridge

Once known as Yutengping Broken Bridge, Longteng Bridge was built in 1905 of bricks and glutinous-rice mortar. This was both the highest-altitude and longest-span railway bridge in Taiwan during the Japanese Colonial Period (1895-1945). Severely damaged in a 1935 earthquake and further damaged in the 1999 '921' Earthquake, the remains now stand as a witness to history.

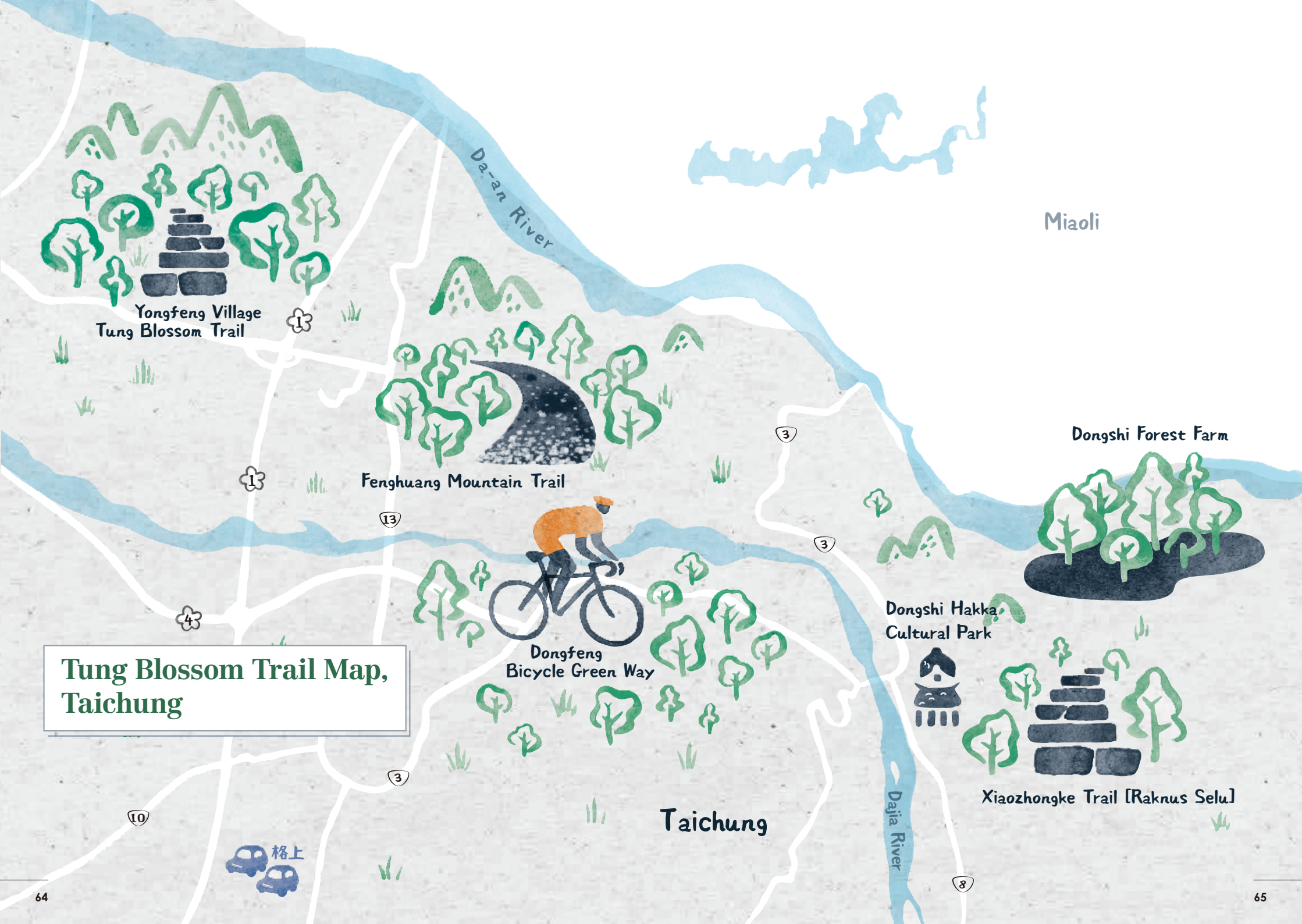
